# ONLINE CREDIT AND RETRIEVAL

For incoming 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders

*Unless you are contacted, classes will take place as scheduled.  
Students must provide their own transportation.*

#### GENERAL INFORMATION:

- **Date:** July 6<sup>th</sup> through August 5<sup>th</sup> (5 weeks, 2 days per week)
- **Time:** 8:00 am – 10:00 am, Monday & Wednesday **OR** Tuesday & Thursday
- **Location:** Monroe High School, (classroom will be assigned on the first day)
- **Cost:** \$ 75 per .5 credit/class
- Limited licenses – only 30 spaces available per session!
- Students may earn .5 credit per class.
- Students will be required to work on assignments outside of class and it “may” be possible for students to complete more classes during the scheduled class period if they put extra effort into their assignments at home.
- Students needing to make up credit will have first priority.

# Monroe High School – Online Credit Retrieval

**You will not receive confirmation** - Students should arrive for their class(es) on the first day of summer school as scheduled. Classes are contingent upon enrollment and you will only be contacted if class is full, cancelled or if there is a schedule change.

**Summer School Attendance:** Students may be absent no more than 10% of the time or 2 days total in grades 10 through 12 (students must receive special permission from the on-site administrator when absences exceed 10%). A student who is constantly tardy (3 tardies = 1 absence), leaves before dismissal time or has excessive absences may be denied credit or be dismissed. Students are expected to arrive just prior to the start of class time and depart promptly when class ends. Absences are monitored daily and parent/guardian is called when students are absent.

**Out-of-district Students:** Out-of-district students pay an additional \$25 per class.
