- Hi Cap (COGAT): Screening will take place during November and December
- **F&P Benchmark Assessments:** Students will be screened by teacher and a team from the district office when they return to in person/hybrid learning. We anticipate this will happen from November January.
- SEL Surveys: Dates have been extended into November.
- **MAP Growth:** Dates have been adjusted to January and May for high school students who are enrolled in Math and ELA courses.
