The training consisted of:	

- A. An explanation of universal blood and body fluid precautions to include:
 - use of gloves and other protective barriers
 - handwashing procedures
 - diapering procedure
 - housekeeping practices
 - disinfection of toys and changing table mats
 - laundry instructions for clothing soiled with body fluids
 - volunteer training in universal precautions
- B. A general explanation of epidemiology and transmission concerns of infectious agents in the school setting, to include specific information regarding:
 - Cytomegalovirus (CMV)
 - Fifth Disease
 - Hepatitis A Virus
 - Hepatitis B Virus
 - Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)
- C. An explanation of WAC 296-62-08001 Bloodborne Pathogens;
- D. A general explanation of the Monroe School District Infectious Disease Policy with specific discussion regarding the Infection Control Program (ICP);
- E. An explanation of the appropriate methods for recognizing tasks and other activities that may involve exposure to blood and other potentially infectious materials;
- F. Information on the hepatitis B vaccine, including information on its efficacy, safety, method of administration, benefits of vaccination, and that vaccination series will be offered free of charge;
- G. Information on the appropriate actions to take and persons to contact in an emergency involving blood or other potentially infectious materials;
