

## **Substance Abuse Checklist**

Substance Abuse Assessment, Treatment, and Return to School

A student is placed on Emergency Expulsion. While on emergency expulsion, the student will be excluded from attendance at all school and school-related programs and activities.

- Complete all make up work and make arrangements with teachers for completing missed tests, projects, and other in-class activities.
  Fill out a homework request form through the attendance office
- ] Make an appointment with an approved outpatient chemical dependency treatment agency. Request that the agency fax to the school:

Agency verification of scheduled appointment After completion of the assessment, request that the agency fax to the school:

Sverification of Assessment, request that the agency fax to the sensor.

- Parents/guardians and the student may be asked to schedule a re-entry meeting with the administrator.
- Following the assessment and regardless of whether the agency recommends treatment, a district-recognized alcohol and drug information class must be completed within 30 days of the offense. The agency/student must provide to the school:

Serification of completion of approved class

] If a treatment plan is recommended, comply with all recommendations of the assessment. After thirty (30) days of entering into treatment, the agency/student must provide to the school:

Serification confirming full compliance with the treatment plan

Support Continue to provide verification every 30 days until treatment is completed. When treatment plan is completed, the agency/student must provide to the school:

Serification of completion of treatment

☐ If at any time the student is determined by an administrator to be out of compliance with the treatment plan and/or is not following the conditions set forth in the terms of re-entry to school, the emergency expulsion will be immediately reinstated.
