4. Describe the action steps the school/district will take to reduce the opportunity gap in student possession of ASB cards and/or participation in extracurricular activities for the up coming school year.

Monroe High School's ASB and Athletic Programs have met to determine steps that can be taken to reduce the opportunity gap in ASB card possession and extracurricular.

To increase ASB card possession the ASB students will create additional advertising to show the benefits of having an ASB card. This advertising will be done via social media, signage for picture days and various other events throughout the school year. The advertising will also list ways to get support for an ASB card should the students and families have a need.

The ASB Bookkeeper will also develop a communication process to connect with students that have been identified as Consented to Share for the HB1660 benefits and ensure they are aware of their benefits. Communication goes to the parents/guardians currently; however, we have found students are unaware of the actual benefits.

To increase Athletic participation the Athletics department has created a plan to advertise via social media and signage throughout the school well in advance of registration opening for seasons. In addition, the Athletic Director will be working with coaches and captains to look at hosting tables at lunches and school events to encourage participation and excitement around their programs. Open fields may be available for all students to try sports dependent upon district and athletic policies.
