SECTION 1: Directory Information and Student Images

Most information about our students is confidential and cannot be made public without the consent of parents/guardians. However, a federal law called the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) allows each student's "directory information" to be released without specific consent from parents. Directory information includes:

- Student's name, address & telephone number
- Participation in officially recognized sports and activities
- Grade level, dates of attendance, withdrawal and/or graduation
- Weight and height of members of athletic teams
- Diplomas and awards received
- Current and most recent previous school attended
- Photos, videos and other images in which the student appears

By marking the box below, you are restricting release of all directory information about your child – including his or her name and photo in ALL school and district publications. This includes the yearbook, school newsletters, daily bulletin, graduation/honor roll lists, school program, athletic programs or PTA materials, etc. Artwork with his/her name on it will not be entered in outside competition, nor will public recognition for his/her accomplishments be given in any news media.
Do NOT release my student's directory information except as required by law. My student will NOT be included in the yearbook, school newsletter, daily bulletin or any other school related information.
