## Memorandum of Agreement Between Monroe Education Association And Monroe School District

- All educators in the MEA bargaining unit, who were not on a leave of absence on September 4th, will be compensated at their per diem rate of pay for the Professional Improvement Day held on September 4, 2020.
- 3. Compensation for the Professional Improvement Day will be paid in the October 2020 paycheck.
