

Memorandum of Agreement
Between the

And the
Monroe School District

Health and Safety Accommodation for Programs Where Snacks are Served During the Instructional Time

In order to accommodate individual program needs where snack(s) are served during the instructional time of the school day, the District and the Association agree to the following: Students may eat snack(s) in the classroom only when the program being taught requires a snack to be served during the instructional portion of the day and when the Department of Health (DOH) health and safety guidelines are being followed. The guidelines that must be followed are;

1. wash/sanitize hands before and after the consumption of snacks,
2. wash/sanitize surfaces that have been eaten on,
3. ensure six feet of social distance between students while eating snacks,
4. students are to immediately put their masks back on after any/all snacks are consumed, and
5. other mitigants will be in place such as either a door opened for added air ventilation or an additional HEPA filtration unit is placed in the classroom.

Individuals participating in such programs within the District will notify Joanne Dickinson and Robyn Hayashi for the purposes of oversight and compliance with the Department of Health guidelines.
