Personalized Pathway Requirements (PPR) are related courses that lead to a specific post high school career or educational outcome chosen by the student based on the student's interests and their High School and Beyond Plan. They may include Career and Technical Education classes and are intended to provide a focus for the student's learning. Students may use a PPR class for 1 of 2 required Art Credits and/or up to 2 credits of the World Language requirement. Students may earn up to 3 credits upon successful completion of PPR classes.

Although fine art and world language may be waived based on a student's PPR, college entrance requirements generally remain the same. Direct admission into a 4-year college or university usually requires at least 2 years of successful completion of the same world language and 1 year of fine art.
